Annual Elections: Along with the usual highly informative content of our meeting (and this meeting is definitely no exception), the NEODBUG business meeting and board elections will be held at November's meeting as well. This is where you decide if the coaching staff changes. Here's how the board elections will proceed.

The current Board of Trustees will present to the membership a slate of candidates and will conduct an election for the Board of Trustees for 2003.

The Board of Trustees will elect officers at the December Board meeting.

The make up of your Board of Trustees will not change in 2003. We are fortunate to have the board returning for the upcoming year. This is a core group of individuals that are dedicated to providing a forum for Database related issues and education.

This organization depends on the Board of Trustees to plan our Quarterly meetings, handle membership, meeting registrations, oversee the finances, and generate this Newsletter. Your input is necessary for NEODBUG to continue to prosper as your source for solutions to relational database technical issues. We really read them!

Decisions: The Board of Trustees has completed an examination into ways we can keep this organization on a sound financial footing. We have been able to stabilize our income for the past year while our costs have continued to increase. The Board has decided that as of January 1, 2003:

- The costs of the Quarterly meetings will remain at \$30/\$40/\$50.
- We will be maintaining Corporate Membership fees at \$125 for early membership registration and \$150 for late membership registration.
- We will be offering Special Educational Meeting this year in March of 2003. This will be in lieu of the regular Quarterly meeting in February. We are arranging for a nationally known trainer, Terry Purcell, to come in for a day of training at what will be a very special price for employees of member companies only.
- We are going to suspend the Tools Fair, this year. Attendance was down to about 1/3 of both the vendors and membership. We are planning an August Quarterly meeting to fill the void that is left. Watch for more information on this event.
- We will continue to offer the ability to pre-pay for the year's meetings with your annual Corporate Membership payment. These coupons will continue to redeemable for the cost of a meeting (\$30).
- For every 5th person attending from a Corporate Member company, there will be a \$30 discount to be used towards the cost of that meeting. This discount will be also available for Special Educational Meetings.

Quarterly Program: This quarter's program is awesome! The Agenda Committee has developed another incredible program for November. To start the day, we are very excited to announce that Bob Crane, a Senior DBA from Computer Associates, will give two presentations during the morning. His first presentation is entitled: *The DB2 Log—What's In It for Me?* With the emergence of tools enabling the reading of the DB2 log, this presentation looks at how the information stored there may be used. We start by revisiting the DB2 logging mechanism to understand HOW and WHAT DB2 logs, before looking at the ways in which this valuable resource may be utilized.

Bob's second presentation is: *A Nuts and Bolts Approach to Plans and Packages*. It is a detailed look at how DB2 uses plans, packages and collections. It reviews the precompiled and bind processes in detail with many visual examples of these processes as well as recommendations and explanations for bind parameters. This talk also reviews the catalog and director tables used to maintain and exploit these objects as well as covering the security associated to creating and executing these objects, recommendations for implementation of these objects as well as naming standard suggestions are covered. Problem solving techniques for resolving -805's, -904's, etc are covered with visual aids. Extensive queries to view and manage these objects are presented as well as techniques for package maintenance. Review of V6 objects and their fit into the package scenario as well as some updated v7 info.

Bob earned his MIS Degree from the University of Northern Iowa and accepted a Programmer/Analyst position with State Farm in 1990. He joined The Principal Financial Group as a DBA and team lead in 1995 and was responsible for application and subsystem tuning, backup and recovery, object maintenance, and security while co-chairing DB2 training and standards projects. Bob joined Platinum Technology as a Senior DBA in July 1998, working on-site at MCI/WorldCom supporting CA's DB2 OS/390 products and assisting MCI/WorldCom/EDS with their DB2 efforts. Since that time, Bob has become an IBM Certified Solutions Expert - DB2 V7.1 Database Administration for OS/390 & DB2 UDB V6/V7 User. He gave presentations at IDUG North America 2000, 2001 and 2002, receiving a top ten speaker honor in 2000.

After Lunch, our second speaker of the day will be Scott Hayes. He is the founder of DGI, a company specializing in performance management tools, consulting, and support for DB2 UDB UNIX, Linux, and Windows. Scott is an IBM DB2 Gold Consultant and IBM DB2 Certified Advanced Technical Expert. He is a frequent speaker at International DB2 User Group (IDUG) meetings worldwide, IBM DB2 Technical Conferences, the DB2 Symposium, and regional user groups meetings, as well as a regular contributor to the DB2-L listserver, DB2 Magazine, and the IDUG Solutions Journal.

Scott's talk is titled: *"Cut Query Times in Half: Sort & I/O Tuning"*

This session will teach you how to measure and evaluate DB2 UDB UNIX, Linux, and Windows sort and I/O performance, see measurements used in case studies, and learn how to configure your DB2 UDB engine for optimal query performance. Learn 10 steps towards performance excellence. Many formulas and case studies will be presented to demonstrate the techniques.

Our final speaker of the day will be Bill Schneeweis is an IBM Software IT Specialist. He has 24 years experience in support of IBM database (yes, he was supporting IBM databases before there was a DB2). His industry experience includes:

- Aircraft and Manufacturing (Boeing, Cessna Aircraft, and Raytheon Aircraft)
- Telecommunications (Sprint and Alltel)
- Food Service (Pizza Hut)
- State Government (KS, MO, and OK)
- Health Services

Bill has 3 presentations: the Future of DB2 in two parts: *"DB2 - today and tomorrow"* which examines the architecture of DB2 (all platforms) with an eye toward synergies and future enhancements. Part 2 is titled: *"DB2 Trends"* which deals with the general trends in DB2 and Information Integration – something new from IBM.

Bill's third presentation is titled: *"DB2 Next - What is Known Now About the Next Version of DB2 for z/OS"*. This presentation is a review of what has been disclosed about the next version of mainframe DB2.

NEODBUG CHARTER

STATEMENT

The NEODBUG was formed to promote a public forum for the discussion and awareness of database usage in the Northeast Ohio Data Processing Community.

PURPOSE

- 1) To establish channels for the education and communication of information to and from members in the field of information processing.
- 2) To conduct conferences, meetings, discussion groups, forums, panels, lectures, and other programs concerned with the development and exchange of information among members;
- 3) To encourage and strengthen participation of all qualified users;
- 4) To promote the acceptance of database as the standard database technology for mainframe computers;
- 5) To encourage the development of database compatible products; and
- 6) To provide a forum for the promotion of excellence in information processing through recognition of those individuals who, judged by their peers, put forth the highest effort and succeed in best utilizing the database relations technology within their enterprise.

ORGANIZATION

The NEODBUG consists of an Executive Committee, composed of Officers as follows: Chair, Vice Chair, Treasurer, Secretary, Meeting Facilitator, Special Interest Group (SIG) Coordinator and Advisory Board Members. Companies can enroll a total of five (5) representatives to NEODBUG for the annual corporate fee.
